- ▼ Dave Bennett's **Tribute to Benny Goodman** introduces the vivacious and swinging newcomer, Chelsea Krombach singing Goodman favorites: *Why Don't You Do Right?*, *These Foolish Things*, *Stomping at the Savoy* and other "hits" made famous by Benny's great singers: Peggy Lee, Martha Tilton, Helen Ward, Ella Fitzgerald.
