While performing all over New England, Danny recorded several full length records with an original Ska band. His early career saw international and extensive domestic travel with big bands and jazz bands, several of which won Berklee and Montreal High School Jazz Festivals. After graduating from Berklee College of Music in Boston, MA, with an undergraduate degree in Classical Composition, Danny began performing in studio sessions and teaching private privately in his spare time. He relocated to Las Vegas NV in 2011, where he performed throughout the Las Vegas Strip. After joining DSB in 2015, Danny still manages to balance DSB's touring schedule and teach private drum and guitar lessons from his studio.

In his spare time, Danny focuses on his second passion; his love for the outdoors and remains extremely active in the Southwest's rock climbing, hiking, canyoneering and skiing community.

JUAN DEL CASTILLO // LEAD VOCAL

A native of the Washington D.C. area, Henry started playing piano at the age of three, and shortly thereafter learned guitar and drums. Throughout his childhood and teen years he received many accolades and awards for his singing, including being named the most outstanding high school vocalist in the entirety of his home state of Maryland. Henry then graduated from Carnegie Mellon University with a BFA in Vocal Performance. He spent 6 years singing and acting in New York City, snagging one of the lead roles in the North American tour of *Miss Saigon*.

The famous one, that cuts to black with Don't Stop playing in the background. Henry can be found laughing it up and chowing down on a delicious roast beef sandwich!
