

Jim Curry Music (The Music of John Denver)

Sound Equipment Rider for 6 piece band

Stage:

- Minimum of 20' deep x 30' wide Stage area
- No front curtain is needed (curtains are open for entire show)
- Background- white Cyclorama at back of stage.
Or Projector and Projection Screens for PowerPoint video and slides.

Backline requirements – Venue to Provide:

1. **Full drum set: Drums will not be on a riser if they block the projector – shield may be used**
 - Yamaha, DW or Tama brand 6pc set: 22" bass with tom mount for 10" and 12" toms.
 - Floor tom - 14" or 16"
 - 5 ½" X 14" snare drum
 - Zildjian, Sabian or Paiste brand cymbals with stands: One pair high hats (14"), one ride (22"), 2 light crash (16"), Splash (10")
 - Bass drum foot pedal
 - Drummer's stool (round),
 - A carpet is required under the drum kit.
2. **Percussion**
 - Congas (standard 2 piece set 11" & 12") not on stands
3. **88 key Synthesizer (such as Yamaha Motif or Korg Triton)**

Any other equipment needed shall be provided by buyer's qualified sound company, to adequately provide the sound to the area and to the stage monitors. (i.e.: amplifiers, power supplies, cables and cords, etc...)

Sound requirements:

- 1) One qualified sound technician available for sound check and during the show.
- 2) A minimum of a 20 Channel mixing board
- 3) 6 independent monitors mixes:
 - a) Three floor wedges for front line,
 - b) Three XLR or mono/stereo TRS ¼" line-level monitor inputs for backline.
 - c) **PG will bring their own rolls personal in-ear monitor Pre- amps.**
- 4) EQ rack for house and monitors
- 5) Feedback eliminator or pink-noise capability to set up room properly.
- 6) Reverb effects rack for vocals and flute,
 - a) Two separate reverbs; one for all Vocals, one for Flute
 - b) **Reverb unit to be mixed to front of house and to monitor mix.**
- 7) Proper sized Front-of-house speakers for the size of the venue.
- 8) Eight (8) Boom mic stands
 - a) 4-Vocal microphones
 - b) **1-Flute player will bring her own SM-81 microphone and clip**
 - c) 3- for Drum mics
- 9) Three (3) D.I. boxes (for the 2 guitars and 1 Piano)
- 10) One line XLR for mandolin pre-amp
 - a) **Mandolin player will bring her own Pre Amp**
 - b) **110V standard outlet Power is needed**
- 11) One line XLR for Bass
 - a) **Bass Player will bring his own Pre Amp**
 - b) **110V standard outlet Power is needed**
- 12) All cables and cords to wire the above equipment, including mics and direct boxes to the stage performance locations as indicated in the stage plot below.

6 independent Monitor Mixes: 3 monitor wedges to be provided by Presenter

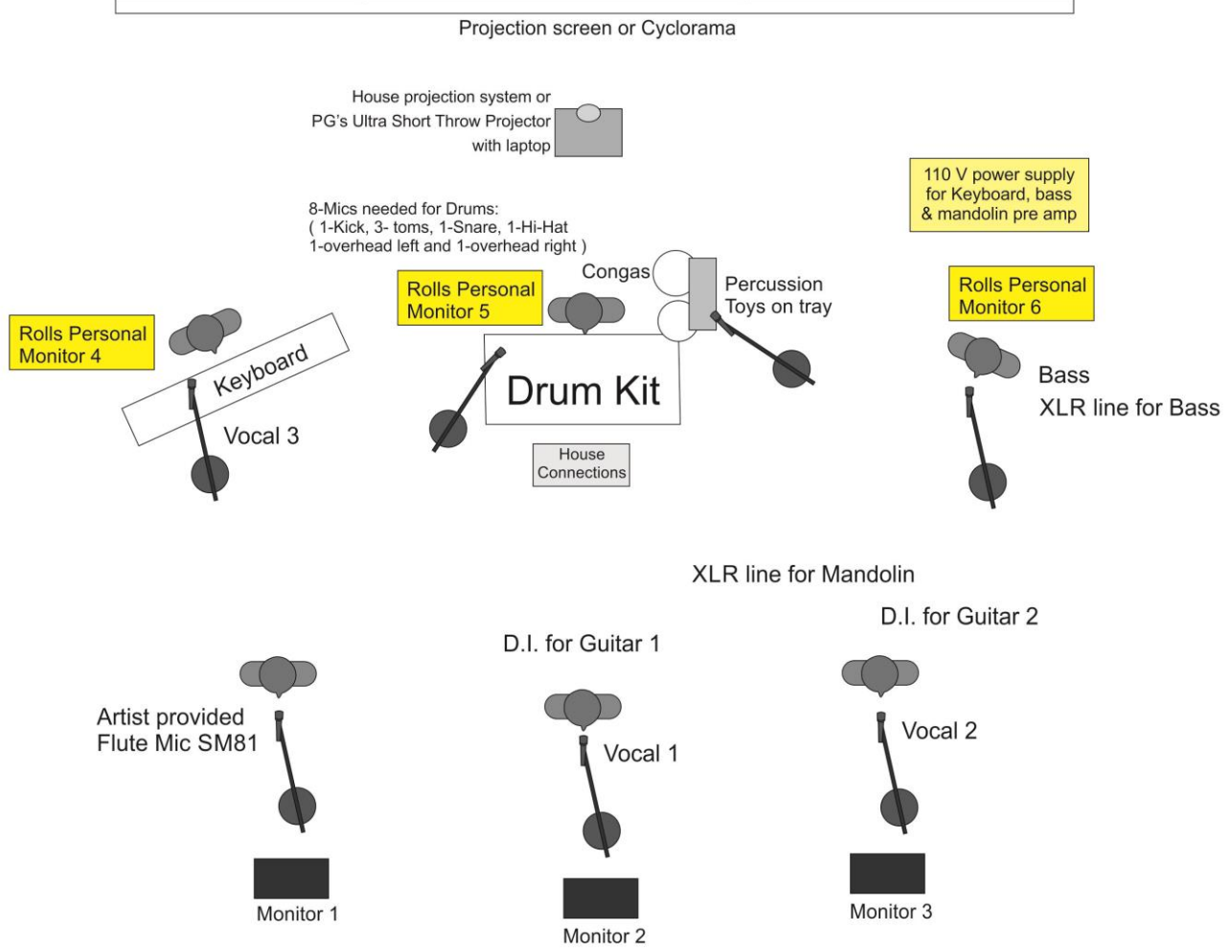
1= stage Right front wedge, 2= center stage front wedge, 3=stage Left front wedge,

4= stage right Keyboard Rolls in Ear* 5= Center stage Drums Rolls in Ear* 6= stage left Bass Rolls in Ear*

* PG will provide the Rolls in-ear personal mixer for mix 4,5,6; an XLR or 1/4" connector for the monitor feed is required
